## Distinguished and Honorary Members

Distinguished and honorary members are appointed by the Board in recognition of exceptional service to OTTIAQ or the profession.

### Criteria

- Current or former OTTIAQ member (with satisfactory grounds for leaving)
- Exceptional services rendered to the profession (organization, promoting the profession)
- International renown
- Honorary distinction (Governor General's Award, CIQ Award of Merit, etc.)
- Achievements in the areas of publications, teaching, research, public presentations at conferences, linguistic management, etc.
- Important contribution as head of an organization related to the profession (OTTIAQ, CTTIC, CIQ, IFT, etc.)

### Supporting documents

- Letter of nomination
- Summary of candidate's achievements
- Letters of recommendation (maximum 3)

### Not eligible

- Board members
- Awards Committee members

Deadline for nominations: June 1

*Note:* All OTTIAQ members, with the exception of Awards Committee members, may personally nominate someone.

Presentation of award: OTTIAQ annual conference

Type of award: Title, free lifetime OTTIAQ membership and commemorative certificate.
